On behalf of the Director-General, I have the honour to invite you to the 26th session of the Intergovernmental Council of the Intergovernmental Hydrological Programme (IHP), which will take place at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris from 5 to 7 June 2024. This session will be preceded by a Scientific Colloquium entitled "Fifty years of evolution of hydrological science: from science to implementation" on 3 June, and a meeting of water-related category 2 centres and UNESCO Chairs on the future of hydrology, as well as a Structured Financing Dialogue, on 4 June. Information on these events will be provided separately.

The provisional agenda for the 26th session of the IHP Council is enclosed for your attention. During this session, the Council will review the progress of IHP-IX after the first two years. It will also review cooperation on water issues within the UN system and the international water agenda. The Celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the IHP and 60 years of water sciences at UNESCO in 2025 will also be an important topic.
